HOLIDAY COOKIES

DEC 5TH

Directions:

1. Combine flour, salt and baking powder in a bowl and set aside.
2. Mix butter and sugar in a bowl for approx. 3-4 minutes. Add egg and vanilla and mix until combined.
3. Mix the dry ingredients into the wet ingredients a little at a time. Mix until dough holds together.
4. Chill dough for a minimum of 2 hours. When done, lightly dust the surface with flour. Roll out dough to 1/4" thickness and cut out shapes.
5. Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Place cookies on an ungreased cookie sheet and bake for 8-10 minutes.
6. Once cooled, decorate with frosting and enjoy!



Ingredients:

- 1c granulated sugar
- 1c unsalted butter (room temp)
- 2 tsp. vanilla
- 1 egg (room temp)
- 3c flour
- 1 1/4 tsp baking powder
- 1/4 tsp salt

PIPE CLEANER ICICLES

Directions:

1. Thread beads onto the pipe cleaner. Remember to leave a bit of space between the beads. Twist the end to secure the beads.
2. Wrap the beaded pipe cleaner around the pencil to create a spiral shape.
3. Pull the top of the pipe cleaner so the spiral is wider at the top. To finish, you can hang the icicles by folding them over the top of the pipe cleaner to create a hook.
4. Hang it up somewhere in your home!

1. Pipe cleaner
2. Assorted beads
3. Pencil
