### Rainforest Adventures

## Important Details

### Please read carefully below before booking.

- \*Reservations are preferable 1 month in advance, but may be made at a minimum of 2 weeks in advance.
- \*We only accept cash or check.
- \*In order to receive the \$6.00 school group rate, you must pay for a minimum of 20 students.
- \*Admission is required for all attendees: students, teachers, etc.
- \*Guaranteed head count must be received 1 week prior to visit. The cost of your visit is determined by the guaranteed head count regardless of absences or no-shows. If additional people attend on the day of visit, the final cost will increase to include the additional visitors.
- \*Please give at least 2 weeks notice in the event of cancellation.
- \*Family memberships do not count towards admission.
